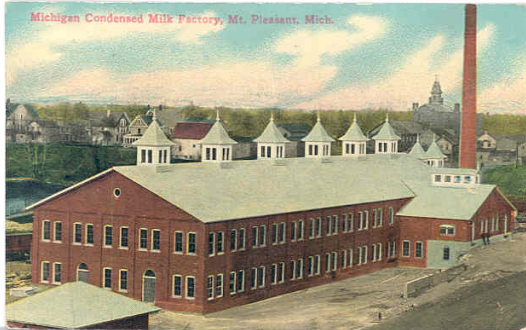


# *West Broadway Revitalization Project Update*



## **City Hall Move Just Around the Corner**

### **THE MOVE**

The first segment of the West Broadway Revitalization Project, which began nearly three years ago with the voters' approval for the sale of City Hall on Main Street, is nearing completion. While a firm date has not been determined for the physical move from one City Hall facility to another, plans have been in the works for some time to accomplish the move with as little disruption in services as possible.

Current City Hall offices at 401 North Main Street will be closed to the public on a Thursday and Friday in the near future and reopen for business at 320 West Broadway Street on the following Monday. This will give City staff four days to pack and transport records and supplies, then unpack and organize them in the new facility.

In the meantime, residents and customers are asked to excuse the mess as City Hall staff continues to sort, toss and pack. Please keep an
